



## Junior Female Cyclist Support Grant Program

### Purpose

- Contribute to the future development of the sport of cycling
- Provide monetary support to promote junior female cycling
  - Assist athletes to compete, develop and realise their potential

### Description

- Provide up to \$500 to a recognised elite junior female cyclist
  - Travel costs
  - Competition entry
  - Training and development costs

### Eureka Cycling will...

- Promote the achievements of the grantee
- Register the grantee as a social member of the club

### The successful cyclist will...

- Keep Eureka Cycling informed of their progress and achievements
- Provide Eureka Cycling with a reconciliation of how the grant funds have been expended
- Maintain exemplary sportsmanship standards
  - Compete within the rules and code of conduct

### Grant Process

- Call for expressions of interest from junior female cyclists within the nominated catchment area
- Cyclists will submit their application to the club within the advertised specified time-frame

### Applications must...

- Address the Assessment criteria
- Explain how the grant would make a difference to their cycling career and aspirations

### Assessment criteria:

- 1) The applicant must have a principal place of residence in one of the following council boundaries:
  - City of Ballarat
  - Golden Plains Shire
  - Hepburn Shire
  - Moorabool Shire
  - Pyrenees Shire
- 2) The applicant must be female aged between 15 and 18
- 3) The applicant must be involved in a formal training and development program (eg VIS or AIS), and have outstanding competition results at the State or National level in the past 12 months

### Conditions

- Eureka Cycling Club Committee will assess applications and approve the successful applicant
- One grant awarded in any 12 month period
  - No further monetary assistance will be provided
- Applicants whom have been suspended for breaches rules or code of conduct will be ineligible
- Grant can only be used towards direct costs of cycling
- Eureka Cycling reserves the right to select the grantee for the Junior Female Cyclist Support Program
